Why do you call me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do what I tell you?

from your pastor’s desk

Grace always comes first. Always!

Jesus said, “If you love me, you will obey my commandments” (John 14:15). However, the scripture also makes plain that, “we love because he first loved us” (1 John 4:19). So even our obedience is a result of God’s grace to us in Christ.

This was true in the Old Testament as well. In Exodus 20 we find the Ten Commandments. These form the foundation for all the moral laws of God. There is no question they should be obeyed. However, before the first commandment is given by God he proclaims to His people, “I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.” Notice, what the Lord has done. He has already saved the children of Israel before calling them to live obediently in a relationship with Him. It doesn’t happen the other way around. Grace comes first.

This means we are not acceptable to God because we do good works; rather we do good works when we are acceptable to God. Friend, the only way for that to happen is through the grace of faith in His Son Jesus.
